A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund to meet its
8 operational expenses for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

9 Section 10. The following named amount, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
11 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the
12 following purpose:

13 To support outreach, research, and
14 training activities5,000,000

15 Section 15. The sum of \$27,000,000, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
17 to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for deposit into
18 the Illinois Prepaid Tuition Trust Fund if, but only if, Public
19 Act 101-0008 takes effect.

1 Section 20. The sum of \$426,140,600, or so much thereof
2 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
3 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant
4 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program, as
5 provided by law, and for agency administrative and operational
6 costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in
7 this Section.

8 Section 25. The sum of \$75,201,300 or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
10 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant
11 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program and
12 also enrolled at two-year higher education institutions, as
13 provided by law, and for agency administrative and operational
14 costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in
15 this section.

16 Section 30. The sum of \$35,000,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
18 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for
19 payments to eligible public universities for grants to students
20 pursuant to the AIM HIGH pilot program.

21 Section 35. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as may
22 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to

1 the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs associated
2 with providing grants to exonerated persons, as provided by
3 law.

4 Section 40. The sum of \$26,400, or so much thereof as may
5 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance
6 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs
7 associated with the Veterans' Home Nurses' Loan Repayment
8 Program pursuant to Public Act 95-0576.

9 Section 45. The sum of \$264,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance
11 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for grants
12 to eligible nurse educators to use for payment of their
13 educational loan pursuant to Public Act 94-1020.

14 Section 50. The following named sums, or so much thereof
15 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the
16 Education Assistance Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
17 Commission for the following purposes:

18 Grants and Scholarships

19 For the payment of scholarships to students
20 who are children of policemen or firemen
21 killed in the line of duty, or who are
22 dependents of correctional officers killed

1	or permanently disabled in the line of	
2	duty, as provided by law	1,273,300
3	For payment of Minority Teacher Scholarships	<u>1,900,000</u>
4	Total	\$3,173,300

5 Section 55. The sum of \$439,900, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance
7 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for the Loan
8 Repayment for Teachers Program.

9 Section 60. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the ISAC Accounts Receivable
11 Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for costs
12 associated with the collection of delinquent scholarship awards
13 pursuant to the Illinois State Collection Act of 1986.

14 Section 65. The sum of \$110,000, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student
16 Assistance Commission from the University Grant Fund for
17 payment of grants for the Higher Education License Plate
18 Program, as provided by law.

19 Section 70. The following named sum, or so much thereof
20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Student
21 Assistance Commission Contracts and Grants Fund to the Illinois

1 Student Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

2 To support outreach, research, and
3 training activities10,000,000

4 Section 75. The following named sum, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Optometric
6 Licensing and Disciplinary Board Fund to the Illinois Student
7 Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

8 Grants and Scholarships
9 For payment of scholarships for the
10 Optometric Education Scholarship
11 Program, as provided by law50,000

12 Section 80. The following named sum, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the National Guard
14 and Naval Militia Grant Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
15 Commission for the following purpose:

16 Grants and Scholarships
17 For payment of Illinois National Guard and
18 Naval Militia Scholarships
19 at State-controlled universities
20 and public community colleges in
21 Illinois to students eligible to
22 receive such awards, as provided by law20,000

1 Section 85. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
 2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Golden Apple Scholars
 3 of Illinois Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission
 4 for the Golden Apple Scholars of Illinois Program, as provided
 5 by law.

6 Section 90. The following named sums, or so much thereof
 7 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 8 Illinois Student Assistance Commission from the Student Loan
 9 Operating Fund for its ordinary and contingent expenses:

1 Congressional Teacher Scholarship Program Fund to the Illinois
2 Student Assistance Commission for the following purpose:

3 For transferring repayment funds collected
4 under the Paul Douglas Teacher Scholarship
5 Program to the U.S. Treasury100,000

6 Section 115. The sum of \$190,000,000, or so much thereof
7 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
8 Loan Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance Commission for
9 distribution when necessary as a result of the following: for
10 guarantees of loans that are uncollectible, for collection
11 payments to the Student Loan Operating Fund as required under
12 agreements with the United States Secretary of Education, for
13 payment to the Student Loan Operating Fund for Default Aversion
14 Fees, for transfers to the U.S. Treasury, or for other
15 distributions as necessary and provided for under the Federal
16 Higher Education Act.

17 Section 120. The sum of \$13,000,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
19 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
20 Commission for allowable uses of federal grant funds related
21 to college access, outreach, and training, including but not
22 limited to funds received under the federal Gaining Early
23 Awareness and Readiness for Undergraduate Program.

1 Section 125. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Student
3 Incentive Trust Fund to the Illinois Student Assistance
4 Commission for the John R. Justice Student Loan Repayment
5 Program.

6 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
7 1, 2020.
