WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to learn of the death of Judy Abruscato of Wheeling, who passed away on December 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Judy Abruscato was born in 1934 and, after the death of her parents, was raised by her grandmother; at the age of 13, she won her first election when she was voted student president at her elementary school; she started working in a Chicago store, where she decorated windows, at age 14; before she turned 16, she began working at a bank, showing other employees how to fill out statements and file; in 2013, at the age of 78, she celebrated her 35th anniversary at MB Financial, where she worked as the Wheeling Branch Manager and Vice President; and

WHEREAS, After moving to Wheeling with her husband in 1969, Judy Abruscato became active in the community; she served on the village's Zoning Board of Appeals and then as a village trustee for 22 years; she was elected president in 2009, a position she held until 2013; and

WHEREAS, Judy Abruscato's community involvement went beyond her service in village government; she was also active in the Wheeling High School Parent Teacher Organization, the

11 decades of her life to all facets of community service and was
12 the definition of what it means to be a public servant; her
13 influence will continue for many years to come; and

16 and Tony (Sam Griffith) Abruscato, the cherished nana of
