1 SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, President Ronald Reagan declared May as National 2 3 Foster Care Month to recognize the important contributions that 4 foster parents make to society and to the most vulnerable among us by opening their homes to abused and abandoned children; and 5 6 WHEREAS, The number of children in foster care in Illinois 7 has been increasing at an alarming pace; thousands of Illinois 8 children, through no fault of their own, have been separated 9 from their families and are living in foster care; and WHEREAS. The number of foster children in Illinois has 10 11 reached more than 18,000 and has increased by more than 1,000 12 over the past four years; and 13 WHEREAS, Children in foster care are of all ages and backgrounds; many of them are accompanied by younger brothers 14 15 and sisters; they need the comfort, support, and security that 16 only a family can provide; and 17 WHEREAS, Many foster children will never be re-united with 18 their biological families; approximately half of foster children will not be returned to their birth families; and 19

WHEREAS, Most of the children under care of the State live

- 1 in temporary situations with either relatives or foster
- 2 families; some live in professionally-staffed group settings;
- 3 and
- 4 WHEREAS, Children deserve the love and security of a home
- 5 and a 'forever' family; adoption offers stability and better
- 6 outcomes for children in foster care, allowing them to flourish
- 7 in a safe, welcoming, and stable environment; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Illinois lags the nation, ranking last among the
- 9 50 states, in the permanent placement and adoption of children
- in its foster care system; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Illinois is committed to ensuring that children
- 12 grow up in healthy, safe, and loving homes; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL
- 14 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare May of 2019
- 15 as Foster Care Month in Illinois and urge the Department of
- 16 Children and Family Services to facilitate and encourage the
- 17 adoption of children in foster care throughout the State; and
- 18 be it further
- 19 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 20 presented to the Director of Children and Family Services.
