1 SENATE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to
3 learn of the death of George Cyriel Lambrecht of East Moline,
4 who passed away on January 12, 2020; and

5 WHEREAS, George Lambrecht was born in East Moline to Cyriel
6 Lambrecht and Bertha Goethals Lambrecht on December 29, 1926;
7 he attended United Township High School where he and his high
8 school golf team placed in state; he married the love of his
9 life, Rachael Jackson Lambrecht, at St. Mary's Catholic Church
10 in Rock Island on August 22, 1953; and

11 WHEREAS, George Lambrecht enlisted in the U.S. Navy and
12 served for two years as a Gunner's Mate on one of the Navy's
13 Landing Craft Support Ships in the Pacific; after returning
14 home from his service, he became a firefighter with the East
15 Moline Fire Department; he eventually became Assistant Fire
16 Chief before retiring after 25 years of service; he also worked
17 as a realtor and sold hundreds of homes in the East Moline
18 area; and

19 WHEREAS, George Lambrecht developed his love of golf while
20 working as a young caddy at the Short Hills Country Club in
21 East Moline, which was his favorite golf course; he loved his
22 family and his country; and

1 WHEREAS, George Lambrecht was preceded in death by his
2 wife, Rachael Jackson Lambrecht; his parents, Cyriel Lambrecht
3 and Bertha Goethals Lambrecht; his sisters, Helen Lambrecht
4 Verstraete and Gabrielle Lambrecht; his brother, Ralph
5 Lambrecht; and his daughter, Ann Lambrecht; and

6 WHEREAS, George Lambrecht is survived by his sister,
7 Margaret Lambrecht Cook; his brother, Al Lambrecht; his
8 children, Joan Lambrecht Cook, John (Nicki) Lambrecht, Dan
