SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Anti-Click Gambling Data Analytics Collection Act. Provides that no entity that operates a remote gambling platform or a subsidiary of the entity shall collect data from a participant with the intent to predict how the participant will gamble in a particular gambling or betting scenario. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning gaming.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Anti-Click Gambling Data Analytics Collection Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act, "remote
- 7 gambling" means gambling in which persons participate by the
- 8 use of remote communication, such as the Internet, telephone,
- 9 television, radio, or any other kind of electronic or other
- 10 technology for facilitating communication.
- 11 Section 10. Data collection prohibited. An entity that
- 12 operates a remote gambling platform or a subsidiary of the
- 13 entity shall not collect data from a participant with the
- 14 intent to predict how the participant will gamble in a
- 15 particular gambling or betting scenario.
- 16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 17 becoming law.
