SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

15 ILCS 20/50-22

Amends the State Budget Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Removes references to General Assembly members from provisions concerning funding for salaries of General Assembly members, judges, and legislative operations. Effective immediately.

- Sec. 50-22. Funding for salaries of General Assembly 8 9 members and judges; legislative operations.
- (a) Beginning July 1, 2014, the aggregate appropriations 10 available for salaries for members of the General Assembly and 11 judges from all State funds for each State fiscal year shall be 12 13 no less than the total aggregate appropriations made available 14 for salaries for members of the General Assembly and judges
- 16 (b) Beginning July 1, 2014, the aggregate appropriations

for the immediately preceding fiscal year.

- available for legislative operations from all State funds for 17
- each State fiscal year shall be no less than the total 18
- 19 aggregate appropriations made available for legislative
- operations for the immediately preceding fiscal year. For 21 purposes of this subsection (b), "legislative operations"
- 22 means any expenditure for the operation of the Office of the
- Auditor General, the House of Representatives, the Senate, the 23

- 1 Legislative Ethics Commission, the Office of the Legislative
- 2 Inspector General, the Joint Committee on Legislative Support
- 3 Services, and the legislative support services agencies.
- 4 (c) If for any reason the aggregate appropriations made
- 5 available are insufficient to meet the levels required by
- 6 subsections (a) and (b) of this Section, this Section shall
- 7 constitute a continuing appropriation of all amounts necessary
- 8 for these purposes. The General Assembly may appropriate
- 9 lesser amounts by law.
