6	Sec. 8. Rules and minimum standards for schools. The
7	Office shall adopt rules and minimum standards for such
8	schools which shall include, but not be limited to, the
9	following:
10	a. Minimum courses of study, resources, facilities,
11	apparatus, equipment, reference material, established
12	records and procedures as determined by the Office.
13	b. Minimum requirements for instructors.
14	c. Minimum basic training requirements, which a
15	trainee must satisfactorily complete before being eligible

for permanent employment as a firefighter in the fire

department of a participating local governmental agency.

Those requirements shall include training in first aid (including cardiopulmonary resuscitation), training in the administration of opioid antagonists as defined in paragraph (1) of subsection (e) of Section 5-23 of the Substance Use Disorder Act, and training in the history of the fire service labor movement using curriculum and instructors provided by a statewide organization representing professional union firefighters in Illinois.

d. Training in effective recognition of and responses to stress, trauma, and post-traumatic stress experienced by firefighters that is consistent with Section 25 of the Illinois Mental Health First Aid Training Act in a peer setting.
