# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 5 changing Section 5-101 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 5/5-101) (from Ch. 110, par. 5-101)

7 Sec. 5-101. Security for costs. In all actions in any 8 court on official bonds for the the use of any person, actions 9 on the bonds of executors, administrators or guardians, qui tam actions, actions on a penal statute, and in all civil 10 actions, where the plaintiff, or person for whose use an 11 action is to be commenced, is not a resident of this State, the 12 13 plaintiff, or person for whose use the action is to be 14 commenced, shall, before he or she institutes such action, file, or cause to be filed, with the clerk of the court in 15 16 which the action is to be commenced, security for costs, 17 substantially in the following form:
