1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Simplified Sales and Use Tax Administration
5 Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 171/3)

7 Sec. 3. Legislative finding. The ~~The~~ General Assembly
8 finds that a simplified sales tax and use tax system will
9 reduce and over time eliminate the burden and cost for all
10 vendors to collect this State's sales and use tax. The General
11 Assembly further finds that this State should participate in
12 multistate discussions to review or amend or both review and
13 amend the terms of the Agreement to simplify and modernize
14 sales tax and use tax administration in order to substantially
15 reduce the burden of tax compliance for all sellers and for all
16 types of commerce.
