

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB1840

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 2705/2705-565

Amends the Illinois Department of Transportation Law. Grants the City of North Chicago an exclusive option to acquire specified property from the Department of Transportation for public purposes for a period of 3 years.

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1 AN ACT concerning property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Department of Transportation Law of the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is amended by changing Section 2705-565 as follows:
- 7 (20 ILCS 2705/2705-565)
- 8 Sec. 2705-565. North Chicago property; study; conveyance.
- 9 (a) The Department shall perform a study of property owned by the Department consisting of approximately 160 acres 10 located in North Chicago, south of IL Route 137, between IL 11 Route 43 and US Route 41. The study shall include, but not be 12 limited to, a survey of the property for the purpose of 13 14 delineating jurisdictional wetlands in accordance with the Interagency Wetland Policy Act of 1989 and identifying 15 16 threatened and endangered species in accordance with the Illinois Endangered Species Protection Act, for the purpose of 17 identifying property no longer needed for highway purposes. 18
 - (b) The Upon completion of the study and for a period ending 3 years after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly, the City of North Chicago shall have an exclusive option to purchase for public purposes those 10acres portions of the property no longer needed for highway

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- purposes, specifically the property south of IL Route 137, 1 between IL Route 43 and US Route 41. for a consideration, which 2 may be de minimis, negotiated by the parties. The Department 3 4 of Transportation is authorized to convey the excess property 5 to the City of North Chicago pursuant to this Section within 3 6 years after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd 94th General Assembly, but may not otherwise convey or 7 8 transfer the property during that period.
 - (c) Any conveyance to the City of North Chicago under this Section shall provide (i) that title to the property reverts to the State of Illinois if the property ceases to be used for public purposes and (ii) the City of North Chicago may lease the property but may not convey its ownership of the property to any party, other than the State of Illinois.
