SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/60

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that notwithstanding any other provision of the Act, the fee for a new license or non-resident license shall be waived if the applicant is an honorably discharged member of the Armed Forces of the United States who has been awarded a marksmanship badge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by changing Section 60 as follows:
- 6 (430 ILCS 66/60)

- 8 (a) All fees collected under this Act shall be deposited 9 as provided in this Section. Application, renewal, and 10 replacement fees shall be non-refundable.
 - (b) An applicant for a new license or a renewal shall submit \$150 with the application, of which \$120 shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$20 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
 - (c) A non-resident applicant for a new license or renewal shall submit \$300 with the application, of which \$250 shall be apportioned to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$40 shall be apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
- 21 (d) A licensee requesting a new license in accordance with 22 Section 55 shall submit \$75, of which \$60 shall be apportioned 23 to the State Police Firearm Services Fund, \$5 shall be

- 1 apportioned to the Mental Health Reporting Fund, and \$10 shall
- 2 be apportioned to the State Crime Laboratory Fund.
- 3 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act, the
- 4 fee for a new license or non-resident license shall be waived
- 5 if the applicant is an honorably discharged member of the
- 6 Armed Forces of the United States who has been awarded a
- 7 marksmanship badge.
