SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Armed Security Protection Act. Provides that for a period of 3 years beginning July 1, 2022, banks, pawn shops, grocery stores, and gas stations in municipalities having a population in excess of 2,000,000 inhabitants must employ and have on the premises at least one guard during the hours they conduct business with the public.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Armed
- 5 Security Protection Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act:
- 7 "Armed private security guard" or "guard" has the meaning
- 8 ascribed to the term "armed employee" under the Private
- 9 Detective, Private Alarm, Private Security, Fingerprint
- 10 Vendor, and Locksmith Act of 2004.
- "Bank" has the meaning ascribed to that term in the
- 12 Illinois Banking Act.
- "Gas station" means a business subject to the Motor Fuel
- 14 Sales Act.
- "Grocery store" means a business engaged in the sale of
- food, beverages and other goods usually used in a home.
- "Pawn shop" means a business subject to the Pawnbroker
- 18 Regulation Act.
- 19 Section 10. Guards required in municipalities having in
- excess of 2,000,000 inhabitants. A bank, gas station, grocery
- 21 store, and pawn shop shall employ and have on its premises at
- least one guard during the hours it is conducting business

- 1 with the public.
- 2 Section 15. Inoperability of Act. This Act is inoperable
- 3 after June 30, 2025.
