SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/25-75

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that any vehicle purchased with State funds shall be a vehicle fueled by electricity or electricity and gasohol, including hybrid vehicles or plug-in hybrid vehicles, when the cost is less than 10% more than a similar gasoline-fueled vehicle.

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by changing Section 25-75 as follows:

- 7 Sec. 25-75. Purchase of motor vehicles.
- 8 (a) Beginning on the effective date of this amendatory Act 9 of the 94th General Assembly, all gasoline-powered vehicles purchased from State funds must be flexible fuel vehicles. 10 July 1, 2007, all gasoline-powered vehicles 11 purchased from State funds must be flexible fuel or fuel 12 efficient hybrid vehicles. For purposes of this Section, 13 14 "flexible fuel vehicles" are automobiles or light trucks that operate on either gasoline or E-85 (85% ethanol, 15% gasoline) 15 fuel and "Fuel efficient hybrid vehicles" are automobiles or 16 17 light trucks that use a gasoline or diesel engine and an electric motor to provide power and gain at least a 20% 18 19 increase in combined US-EPA city-highway fuel economy over the 20 equivalent or most-similar conventionally-powered model.
 - (b) On and after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 94th General Assembly, any vehicle purchased from State funds that is fueled by diesel fuel shall be certified by the

- 1 manufacturer to run on 5% biodiesel (B5) fuel.
- 2 (b-5) On and after January 1, 2016, 15% of passenger
- 3 vehicles, other than Department of Corrections vehicles,
- 4 Secretary of State vehicles (except for mid-sized sedans), and
- 5 Department of State Police patrol vehicles, purchased with
- 6 State funds shall be vehicles fueled by electricity,
- 7 electricity and gasohol (hybrids or plug-in hybrids),
- 8 compressed natural gas, liquid petroleum gas, or liquid
- 9 natural gas, including dedicated or non-dedicated fuel type
- 10 vehicles.
- 11 (b-10) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the
- 12 contrary, any vehicle purchased with State funds shall be a
- 13 vehicle fueled by electricity or electricity and gasohol,
- including hybrid vehicles or plug-in hybrid vehicles, when the
- 15 cost is less than 10% more than a similar gasoline-fueled
- 16 vehicle.
- 17 (c) The Chief Procurement Officer may determine that
- 18 certain vehicle procurements are exempt from this Section
- 19 based on intended use or other reasonable considerations such
- 20 as health and safety of Illinois citizens.
