## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 317/50

Amends the Fire Sprinkler Contractor Licensing Act. Provides that the State Fire Marshal has the power and duty to conduct a study, to be completed on or before December 31, 2021, to examine and detail the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on building safety. Effective immediately.

- 7 Sec. 50. Powers and duties of the State Fire Marshal. The
- 8 State Fire Marshal has all of the following powers and duties:
- 9 (a) To prescribe and furnish application forms, licenses,
- 10 and any other forms necessary under this Act.
- 11 (b) To suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew
- 12 licenses for cause.
- 13 (c) To conduct hearings concerning the suspension,
- 14 revocation, or refusal to issue or renew licenses.
- 15 (d) To levy and collect fines pursuant to this Act.
- 16 <u>(e) To conduct a study, to be completed on or before</u>
- December 31, 2021, to examine and detail the impact of the
- 18 COVID-19 pandemic on building safety.
- 19 <u>(f)</u> To promulgate rules and regulations necessary for
- 20 the administration of this Act.
