Amends the Humane Care for Animals Act and the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that no person shall lead or tether a companion animal from a moving motor vehicle or any device attached thereto.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by
5 adding Section 7.3 as follows:

6 (510 ILCS 70/7.3 new)

7 Sec. 7.3. Leading animal from motor vehicle.

8 (a) No person shall lead or tether a companion animal from
9 a moving motor vehicle or any device attached thereto.

10 (b) For purposes of this Section:

11 "Lead" means to confine by a leash or other device that is
12 controlled by a person, and that fits on the animal's body and
13 limits the animal's movements.

14 "Tether" means to confine by a leash or other device that
15 is attached to a fixed object, and that fits on the animal's
16 body and limits the animal's movements.

17 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
18 Section 11-1433 as follows:

19 (625 ILCS 5/11-1433 new)

20 Sec. 11-1433. Leading animal from motor vehicle.
