

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by
5 adding Section 120 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/120 new)

7 Sec. 120. Undocumented Student Liaison; Undocumented
8 Student Resource Center.

9 (a) Beginning with the 2022-2023 academic year, the Board
10 of Trustees shall designate an employee as an Undocumented
11 Student Resource Liaison to be available on campus to provide
12 assistance to undocumented students and mixed status students
13 within the United States in streamlining access to financial
14 aid and academic support to successfully matriculate to degree
15 completion. The Undocumented Student Liaison shall provide
16 assistance to vocational students, undergraduate students,
17 graduate students, and professional-track students. An
18 employee who is designated as an Undocumented Student Liaison
19 must be knowledgeable about current legislation and policy
20 changes through professional development with the Illinois
21 Dream Fund Commission to provide the wrap-around services to
22 such students. The Illinois Dream Fund Commission shall
23 conduct professional development under this Section. The

1 Illinois Dream Fund Commission's task force on immigration
2 issues and the Undocumented Student Liaison shall ensure that
3 undocumented immigrants and students from mixed status
4 households receive equitable and inclusive access to the
5 University's retention and matriculation programs.

6 The Board shall ensure that an Undocumented Student
7 Liaison is available at each campus of the University. The
8 Undocumented Student Liaison must be placed in a location that
9 provides direct access for students in collaboration with the
10 retention and matriculation programs of the University. The
11 Undocumented Student Liaison shall report directly to senior
12 leadership and shall assist leadership with the review of
13 policies and procedures that directly affect undocumented and
14 mixed status students.

15 An Undocumented Student Liaison may work on outreach

8 Center is not required under this Section.

9 The board may seek and accept any financial support
10 through institutional advancement, private gifts, or donations
11 to aid in the creation and operation of and the services
12 provided by an Undocumented Student Resource Center.
