2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 3438 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

13 within the United States in streamlining access to financial

15 completion. The Undocumented Student Liaison shall provide
16 assistance to vocational students, undergraduate students,

1 graduate students, and professional-track students. An
2 employee who is designated as an Undocumented Student Liaison
3 must be knowledgeable about current legislation and policy
4 changes through professional development with the Illinois
5 Dream Fund Commission to provide the wrap-around services to
6 such students. The Illinois Dream Fund Commission shall
7 conduct professional development under this Section. The
8 Illinois Dream Fund Commission's task force on immigration
9 issues and the Undocumented Student Liaison shall ensure that
10 undocumented immigrants and students from mixed status
11 households receive equitable and inclusive access to the
12 University's retention and matriculation programs.

12 An Undocumented Student Resource Center may be housed
13 within an existing student service center or academic center,
14 and the new construction of an Undocumented Student Resource
15 Center is not required under this Section.

16 The board may seek and accept any financial support
17 through institutional advancement, private gifts, or donations
18 to aid in the creation and operation of and the services
19 provided by an Undocumented Student Resource Center.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
21 2021.".
