Amend House Bill 3881 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Hazardous Materials 4 5 Transportation Act is amended by changing Section 3 as 6 follows: 7 (430 ILCS 30/3) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 700-3) Sec. 3. Unless the context otherwise clearly requires, as 8 9 used in this Act: 10 "Commerce" means trade, traffic, commerce or transportation within the State; 11 12 "Department" means the Illinois Department of 13 Transportation; "Discharge" means leakage, seepage, or other release; 14 "Hazardous material" means a substance or material in a 15 quantity and form determined by the United States Department 16

- of Transportation to be capable of posing an unreasonable risk to health and safety or property when transported in commerce;
- "Knowingly" means a person has actual knowledge of the facts giving rise to the violation or a reasonable person acting in the circumstances and exercising due care would have
- 6 such knowledge;
- 7 "Law Enforcement Officials" means the Illinois State
- 8 Police or any duly authorized employees of a local
- 9 governmental agency who are primarily responsible for
- 10 prevention or detection of crime and enforcement of the
- 11 criminal code and the highway and traffic laws of this State or
- 12 any political subdivision of such State;
- "Local road" means any State or local highway except for
- 14 (i) a highway with 4 or more lanes, or (ii) an interstate
- 15 highway.
- 16 "Person" means any natural person or individual,
- 17 governmental body, firm, association, partnership,
- 18 copartnership, joint venture, company, corporation, joint
- 19 stock company, trust, estate or any other legal entity or
- 20 their legal representative, agent or assigns;
- "Transports" or "transportation" means any movement of
- 22 property over the highway and any loading, unloading or
- 23 storage incidental to such movement.
