

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB4081

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Vaccine Credential Act. Provides that a unit of local government or the State may not require a person to have a vaccine credential or show a vaccine credential before the person enters a public event or public venue. Limits home rule powers. Defines "vaccine credential" as any written or electronic record evidencing that a person has received a vaccine. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Vaccine Credential Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. As used in this Act, "vaccine
- 7 credential" means any written or electronic record evidencing
- 8 that a person has received a vaccine.
- 9 Section 10. Vaccine credentials for public events or
- 10 venues. A unit of local government or the State may not require
- 11 a person to have a vaccine credential or show a vaccine
- 12 credential before the person enters a public event or public
- 13 venue.
- 14 Section 15. Home rule. A home rule unit may not regulate
- 15 vaccine credentials in a manner inconsistent with this Act.
- 16 This Act is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of
- 17 Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent
- 18 exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised
- 19 by the State.
- 20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon

1 becoming law.
