SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-405.2 from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-405.2

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that the Secretary of State shall refuse to issue any license plates bearing a reference to an organization organization or person included on the Federal Bureau of Investigation's or United States Department of Homeland Security's domestic and international terrorist lists.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 changing Section 3-405.2 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-405.2) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-405.2)

7 Sec. 3-405.2. Improper plates. The Secretary of State 8 shall refuse to issue any license plates bearing a combination 9 of letters or numbers, or both, which creates a potential duplication or, in the opinion of the Secretary, (1) would 10 substantially interfere with plate identification for law 11 12 enforcement purposes, (2) is misleading, or (3) creates a 13 connotation that is offensive to good taste and decency, 14 including any license plate bearing a reference to an organization or person included on the Federal Bureau of 15 16 Investigation's or United States Department of Homeland 17 Security's domestic and international terrorist lists.

18 The Secretary may revoke any such plates issued 19 previously. Any person who has his or her plates revoked under 20 this Section may acquire at no charge new plates and any 21 required stickers of the same category and for the same period 22 of registration.
