1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Plumbing License Law is amended by
 changing Sections 2.5 and 29.5 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 320/2.5)

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(Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2024)

Sec. 2.5. Irrigation contractors; lawn sprinkler systems.

9 (a) Every irrigation contractor doing business in this State shall annually register with the Department. Every 10 irrigation contractor shall provide to the Department his or 11 her business name and address, telephone number, name of 12 principal, FEIN number, and an original certificate of 13 14 insurance documenting that the irrigation contractor carries general liability insurance with a minimum of \$100,000 per 15 16 occurrence, bodily injury insurance with a minimum of \$300,000 17 per occurrence, property damage insurance with a minimum of \$50,000, and worker's compensation insurance with a minimum of 18 19 \$500,000. No registration may be issued in the absence of the certificate of insurance. The certificate must be in force at 20 21 all times for registration to remain valid.

22 On a form provided by the Department, every irrigation 23 contractor must provide to the Department an indemnification HB4245 Enrolled - 2 - LRB102 21906 SPS 31027 b

bond in the amount of \$20,000 or an irrevocable letter of 1 2 credit from a financial institution guaranteeing that funds 3 shall be available only to the Department and shall be released upon written notification by the Department in the 4 5 same amount for any work on lawn sprinkler systems performed by the registered irrigation contractor. The letter of credit 6 7 shall be printed on the letterhead of the issuing financial 8 institution, be signed by an officer of the same financial 9 institution, name the Department as the sole beneficiary, and 10 expire on February 28 of each year.

11 Every irrigation contractor doing business in this State 12 shall also register with the Department each and every employee who installs or supervises the installation of lawn 13 14 sprinkler systems. The registration shall include the 15 employee's name, home address, and telephone number. The 16 Department may provide by rule for the administration of 17 registrations under this subsection. The annual registration fee shall be set by the Department pursuant to Section 30 of 18 19 this Act. Each registered irrigation contractor must provide 20 proof that he or she employs at least one irrigation employee 21 who has completed and passed an approved class in the design 22 and installation of lawn sprinkler systems.

(b) A licensed plumber or licensed apprentice plumber may
install a lawn sprinkler system connected to any water source
without registration under this Section.

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(c) A licensed plumber shall inspect every sprinkler

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system installed by an irrigation contractor to ensure the 1 2 provisions of this Section have been met and that the system 3 works mechanically. The inspecting A licensed plumber shall make the physical connection between a lawn sprinkler system 4 5 and the backflow prevention device. The inspecting licensed plumber shall inspect every aspect of the sprinkler system, 6 including all piping, fittings, and heads, to ensure the 7 8 provisions of this Section have been met.

9 Upon the installation of every lawn sprinkler system in 10 this State from the effective date of this amendatory Act of 11 the 91st General Assembly forward, a licensed plumber shall 12 affix to the backflow prevention device a tag certifying that 13 installation of that system has been completed in the compliance with the minimum code of plumbing standards 14 promulgated under this Act. The Department shall provide by 15 16 rule for the registration of every lawn sprinkler system 17 installed after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly, including the means by which the 18 Department shall be able to identify by registration number 19 20 the identity of the responsible irrigation contractor and by license number the identity of the responsible licensed 21 22 plumber. No lawn sprinkler system installed after the 23 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly may be operated without the certification tag 24 25 required under this Section.

26 The registered irrigation contractor and the licensed

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plumber whose identifying information is contained on the 1 2 certification tag shall both be subject to the penalty provisions of this for violations 3 Act for improper installation of a lawn sprinkler system installed after the 4 5 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 91st General 6 Assembly.

7 (d) An irrigation contractor who has registered with the 8 Department 7 or fewer persons who are authorized to install or 9 supervise the installation of lawn sprinkler systems shall 10 either employ or contract with at least one licensed plumber 11 who shall install or be responsible for the installation of 12 every lawn sprinkler system installed after the effective date 13 of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly. The 14 licensed plumber shall inspect the risers and sprinkler heads 15 before backfilling.

16 An irrigation contractor who has registered with the 17 Department 8 to 12 persons who are authorized to install or supervise the installation of lawn sprinkler systems shall 18 either employ or contract with at least 2 licensed plumbers 19 20 who shall install or be responsible for the installation of every lawn sprinkler system installed after the effective date 21 22 of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly. A 23 licensed plumber shall inspect the risers and sprinkler heads 24 before backfilling.

25 An irrigation contractor who has registered with the 26 Department 13 to 20 persons who are authorized to install or HB4245 Enrolled - 5 - LRB102 21906 SPS 31027 b

supervise the installation of lawn sprinkler systems shall either employ or contract with at least 3 licensed plumbers who shall install or be responsible for the installation of every lawn sprinkler system installed after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly. A licensed plumber shall inspect the risers and sprinkler heads before backfilling.

8 An irrigation contractor who has registered with the 9 Department 21 to 28 persons who are authorized to install or 10 supervise the installation of lawn sprinkler systems shall 11 either employ or contract with at least 4 licensed plumbers 12 who shall install or be responsible for the installation of every lawn sprinkler system installed after the effective date 13 of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly. A 14 15 licensed plumber shall inspect the risers and sprinkler heads 16 before backfilling.

17 An irrigation contractor who has registered with the Department 29 to 35 persons who are authorized to install or 18 19 supervise the installation of lawn sprinkler systems shall 20 either employ or contract with at least 5 licensed plumbers who shall install or be responsible for the installation of 21 22 every lawn sprinkler system installed after the effective date 23 of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly. A licensed plumber shall inspect the risers and sprinkler heads 24 25 before backfilling.

26 An irrigation contractor who has registered with the

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Department 36 or more persons who are authorized to install or 1 2 supervise the installation of lawn sprinkler systems shall either employ or contract with at least 6 licensed plumbers 3 who shall install or be responsible for the installation of 4 5 every lawn sprinkler system installed after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 91st General Assembly. A 6 7 licensed plumber shall inspect the risers and sprinkler heads 8 before backfilling.

9 The Department may provide by rule for the temporary 10 waiver process for registered irrigation contractors who are 11 unable to comply with the requirements of this subsection. 12 When a temporary waiver is granted, it shall not be for a 13 duration of more than 3 consecutive months. Upon the expiration of a temporary waiver issued by the Department, the 14 15 registered irrigation contractor shall demonstrate that 16 justifiable reasons exist why he or she is still unable to 17 comply with the requirements of this subsection, despite good faith efforts to comply with the requirements. In no case 18 19 shall a temporary waiver be granted for an irrigation 20 contractor for more than a total of 6 months in a 2-year two-year period. In no case shall an irrigation contractor be 21 22 relieved of the requirement that a licensed plumber shall 23 inspect every sprinkler system installed by an irrigation contractor to ensure the provisions of this Section have been 24 25 met and that the system works mechanically and make the 26 physical connection between a sprinkler system and the

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1 backflow prevention device.

2 (e) No person shall attach to a lawn sprinkler system any
3 fixture intended to supply water for human consumption.

No person shall attach to a lawn sprinkler system any fixture other than the backflow prevention device, sprinkler heads, valves, and other parts integral to the operation of the system, unless the fixture is clearly marked as being for non-potable uses only.

9 (f) A college, university, trade school, vocational 10 school, or association that has established a program 11 providing a course of instruction in lawn sprinkler design and 12 installation may submit a letter to the Department requesting 13 approval of its program or course of instruction.

The request for approval shall include information on the curriculum offered by the program and the qualifications of the organization. The course shall consist of a minimum of 2 days of classroom education and an exam and shall include a provision for continuing education.

19 The Department shall evaluate the curriculum and 20 organization before making a determination to approve or deny 21 a request for approval.

In addition to providing to the Department the names of licensed plumbers who are employed by or contract with an irrigation contractor, an irrigation contractor must also provide to the Department the names of employees who have successfully completed an approved course on the installation HB4245 Enrolled - 8 - LRB102 21906 SPS 31027 b

of lawn sprinkler systems and proof that the course was successfully completed and that continuing education is also being completed.

(g) All automatically operated lawn sprinkler systems
shall have furnished and installed technology that inhibits or
interrupts operation of the landscape irrigation system during
periods of sufficient moisture or rainfall. The technology
must be adjustable either by the end user or the irrigation
contractor.

10 This subsection (g) does not apply to systems operating on 11 golf courses or agricultural lands.

12 The requirements of this subsection (g) apply to all 13 landscape irrigation systems installed after January 1, 2009. 14 (Source: P.A. 94-101, eff. 1-1-08; 95-421, eff. 1-1-09.)

Sec. 29.5. Unlicensed and unregistered practice;
violation; civil penalties.

18 (a) A person who practices, offers to practice, attempts 19 to practice, or holds himself or herself out to practice as a plumber or plumbing contractor without being licensed or 20 21 registered under this Act, shall, in addition to any other 22 penalty provided by law, pay a civil penalty to the Department in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for each offense as 23 24 determined by the Department. The civil penalty shall be 25 assessed by the Department after a hearing is held in HB4245 Enrolled - 9 - LRB102 21906 SPS 31027 b

1 accordance with the provisions set forth in this Act regarding 2 the provision of a hearing for the discipline of a licensee or 3 registrant.

4 (b) The Department has the authority and power to 5 investigate any person who practices, offers to practice, 6 attempts to practice, or holds himself or herself out to 7 practice as a plumber or plumbing contractor without being 8 licensed or registered under this Act, or as an irrigation 9 contractor without being registered under this Act.

10 (c) The civil penalty shall be paid within 60 days after 11 the effective date of the order imposing the civil penalty. 12 The order shall constitute a judgment and may be filed and execution had on the judgment in the same manner as a judgment 13 14 from a court of record. All fines and penalties collected by 15 the Department under this Section of the Act and accrued 16 interest shall be deposited into the Plumbing Licensure and 17 Program Fund for use by the Department in performing activities relating to the administration and enforcement of 18 19 this Act.

20 (d) A person who practices, offers to practice, or holds 21 himself or herself out to practice as an irrigation contractor 22 without being registered under this Act shall be subject to 23 the following:

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(1) For a first offense:

(A) Where no violations of the Illinois Plumbing
Code are found, the person shall pay a civil penalty of

\$1,000 and may be referred to the State's Attorney or
 the Attorney General for prosecution under Section 29
 of this Act.

(B) Where violations of the Illinois Plumbing Code 4 5 are found, the person shall pay a civil penalty of \$3,000 (the amount of \$3,000 may be reduced to \$1,000 6 7 upon the condition that the unregistered person pays for a licensed plumber who is acceptable to the other 8 party to the original contract or agreement to correct 9 10 the violations of the Illinois Plumbing Code) and may 11 be referred to the State's Attorney or the Attorney 12 General for prosecution under Section 29 of this Act. (2) For a second offense: 13

(A) Where no violations of the Illinois Plumbing
Code are found, the person shall pay a civil penalty of
\$3,000 and may be referred to the State's Attorney or
the Attorney General for prosecution under Section 29
of this Act.

19 (B) Where violations of the Illinois Plumbing Code 20 are found, the person shall pay a civil penalty of 21 \$5,000 (the amount of \$5,000 may be reduced to \$3,000 22 upon the condition that the unregistered person pays 23 for a licensed plumber who is acceptable to the other 24 party to the original contract or agreement to correct 25 the violations of the Illinois Plumbing Code) and may 26 be referred to the State's Attorney or the Attorney HB4245 Enrolled - 11 - LRB102 21906 SPS 31027 b

General for prosecution under Section 29 of this Act. (3) For a third or subsequent offense, the person shall pay a civil penalty of \$5,000 and be referred to the State's Attorney or the Attorney General for prosecution under Section 29 of this Act. (e) A registered irrigation contractor, firm, corporation,

7 partnership, or association that directs, authorizes, or 8 allows a person to practice, offer to practice, attempt to 9 practice, or hold himself or herself out to practice as an 10 irrigation employee without being registered under the 11 provisions of this Act, shall be subject to the following:

12

(1) For a first offense, the registrant:

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(A) shall pay a civil penalty of $\frac{$10,000}{$5,000}$;

(B) shall be required to pay for a licensed
plumber who is acceptable to the other party to the
original contract or agreement to correct any
violations of the Illinois Plumbing Code;

18 (C) shall have his, her, or its plumbing license19 suspended; and

20 (D) may be referred to the State's Attorney or the 21 Attorney General for prosecution under Section 29 of 22 this Act.

23 (2) For a second offense, the registrant:

(A) shall pay a civil penalty of \$10,000 \$5,000;
(B) shall be required to pay for a licensed
plumber who is acceptable to the other party to the

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1 original contract or agreement to correct any 2 violations of the Illinois Plumbing Code; 3 (C) shall have his, her, or its registration revoked; and 4 5 (D) shall be referred to the State's Attorney or the Attorney General for prosecution under Section 29 6 7 of this Act. (f) If the inspecting licensed plumber does not inspect 8 9 every sprinkler system installed by an irrigation contractor 10 to ensure the provisions of this Act have been met and that the 11 system works mechanically or signs off on the installation 12 without making the physical connection between a lawn 13 sprinkler system and the backflow prevention device, the 14 licensed plumber: 15 (1) shall pay a civil penalty of \$10,000; 16 (2) shall be required to pay for a licensed plumber 17 who is acceptable to the other party to the original contract or agreement to correct any violations of the 18 19 Act; 20 (3) shall have his, her, or its plumbing license 21 suspended; and 22 (4) may be referred to the State's Attorney or the 23 Attorney General for prosecution under Section 29 of this 24 Act.
