- 9 (a) To complement student financial assistance programs and to enhance their effectiveness for students with 10 dependents, the Illinois Student Assistance Commission shall 11 12 annually include information about the Child Care Assistance 13 Program and the federal dependent care allowance in the 14 language that institutions are required to provide to students eligible for Monetary Award Program grants. The language 15 16 shall, at a minimum, include information about program eligibility and how to apply. The language shall also direct 17 students to the Department of Human Services for additional 18 19 information about the Child Care Assistance Program and to the 20 institution's financial aid office for additional information 21 about the federal dependent care allowance.
- 22 (b) An institution of higher learning that participates in 23 the Monetary Award Program shall provide, at a minimum, the

1 notice described in subsection (a) to all students who are 2 enrolled, or who are accepted for enrollment and are intending 3 to enroll, and who have been identified by the Commission as 4 Monetary Award Program-eligible at the institution. An 5 institution of higher learning shall also provide, at a 6 minimum, the notice described in subsection (a) to any student identified by the institution as a student with dependents. 7 (c) An institution may provide additional information 8

9 <u>about benefits and resources the institution or community</u> 10 <u>offers to the students identified in subsection (b). If</u> 11 <u>possible, the institution may designate a public benefits</u> 12 <u>liaison or single point person to assist students in taking</u> 13 <u>the necessary steps to obtain public benefits if eligible.</u>

14 (d) The Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to
 15 implement this Section on or before October 1, 2022.
