SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$3,000,000 from the State Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Department of Public Health to be used by the Department for the establishment and operation of a hotline for complaints, reports, and allegations of conduct, including, but not limited to, fraud or misconduct, committed by laboratories in the State that process tests for COVID-19. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The amount of \$3,000,000, or so much of that amount
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Coronavirus
6 Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Department of Public
7 Health for the establishment and operation of a hotline for
8 complaints, reports, and allegations of conduct, including, but
9 not limited to, fraud or misconduct, committed by laboratories
10 in the State that process tests for COVID-19.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
12 becoming law.
