The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 11 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call 12 13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act. 14
- Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may 15 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 17 Commerce Commission for refunds. 18
