The sum of \$13,000, or so much thereof as may he necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund for grants to the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for ovarian cancer research, education, screening, and treatment. -27- LRB102 26309 RJF 36328 b

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Section 260. The sum of \$6,000, or so much thereof as may he necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Sheet Metal Workers International Association of Illinois Fund for grants for charitable purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the Sheet Metal Workers International Association.

7 Section 265. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as 8 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 9 of State from the Illinois Police Association Fund for 10 providing death benefits for the families of police officers 11 killed in the line of duty, and for providing scholarships, for 12 graduate study, undergraduate study, or both, to children and 13 spouses of police officers killed in the line of duty.

Section 270. The sum of \$7,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for grants to the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes.

Section 275. The sum of \$17,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Fraternal Order of Police Fund for grants to 1 the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police to increase the 2 efficiency and professionalism of law enforcement officers in 3 Illinois, to educate the public about law enforcement issues, 4 to more firmly establish the public confidence in law 5 enforcement, to create partnerships with the public, and to 6 honor the service of law enforcement officers.

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Section 280. The sum of \$40,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of Illinois Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for educational programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how to legally and more safely share the roadways.

Section 285. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the St. Jude Children's Research Fund for grants to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital for pediatric treatment and research.

18 Section 290. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may 19 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 20 of State from the Ducks Unlimited Fund for grants to Ducks 21 Unlimited, Inc. to fund wetland protection, enhancement, and 22 restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund education and outreach for media, volunteers, members, and the general public regarding waterfowl and wetlands conservation in the State of Illinois, and to cover reasonable cost for Ducks Unlimited plate advertising and administration of the wetland conservation projects and education program.

6 Section 295. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may 7 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from 8 the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs associated with 9 enforcement of the Family Financial Responsibility Law.

10 Section 300. The sum of \$700,000, or so much thereof as may 11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 12 of State from the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund for 13 grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation, Inc. 14 for building and maintaining a memorial and park, holding an 15 annual memorial commemoration, giving scholarships to children 16 of State police officers killed or catastrophically injured in 17 the line of duty, and providing financial assistance to police 18 officers and their families when a police officer is killed 19 or injured in the line of duty.

20 Section 305. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may 21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 22 of State from the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Scholarship

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1 and Training Fund for grants to the Illinois Sheriffs' 2 Association for scholarships obtained in a competitive process 3 to attend the Illinois Teen Institute or an accredited college 4 or university, for programs designed to benefit the elderly and 5 teens, and for law enforcement training.

6 Section 310. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 8 of State from the Alzheimer's Awareness Fund for grants to the 9 Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders Association, Greater 10 Illinois Chapter, for Alzheimer's care, support, education, and 11 awareness programs.

Section 315. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may he necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of State from the Illinois Nurses Foundation Fund for grants to the Illinois Nurses Foundation, to promote the health of the public by advancing the nursing profession in this State.

17 Section 320. The sum of \$3,000, or so much thereof as may 18 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 19 of State from the Hospice Fund for grants to a statewide 20 organization whose primary membership consists of hospice 21 programs.

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1 Section 325. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as may 2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary 3 of State from the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund for grants to the Rantoul Historical Society and Museum, or any 4 other charitable foundation responsible for the former exhibits 5 6 and collections of the Chanute Air Museum, for operational and program expenses of the Chanute Air Museum and any other 7 structure housing exhibits and collections of the Chanute Air 8 9 Museum.

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Section 330. The sum of \$11,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for operating program expenses related to the enforcement of administering laws related to vehicles and transportation.

The sum of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof as 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 18 to the Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary of 19 State costs associated with the implementation of the provisions of Article XIV of the Illinois Constitution, 20 21 including, limitation, the without duties under the 22 Constitutional Convention Act and the Illinois Constitutional 23 Amendment Act.
