1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, Illinois is a rich agricultural state, home to over 1 million farmers and over 72,000 farms that grow fruits and vegetables and raise livestock; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Almost 50% of all land in the United States is set 6 aside for farming, including 75% of all land in Illinois; and
- WHEREAS, Farming is a vital part of the Illinois economy as it generates over \$19 billion each year; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Farmers generally do not turn a profit from their 10 work until they have been in the sector for several years, 11 which makes this necessary profession a risky endeavor; and
- WHEREAS, Student loan debt is on the rise, totaling over
 \$1.5 trillion and creating an additional barrier for young
 farmers to make a living, leading many young people to steer
 away from farming as a profession; and
- WHEREAS, The number of beginning farmers fell 20% between 2007 and 2012; and
- WHEREAS, The average age of farmers in the United States is continually rising, climbing to over 58 in 2012 from 49 in

1 1945, which means young farmers are disappearing from the

- 2 economy; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The United States will see 66% of its
- 4 farmer-owned land needing a transfer in ownership within the
- 5 next 25 years; the United States also only added 1,220 young
- 6 operators to its farming economy, which means there are not
- 7 enough new farmers to handle the transfer of land that will
- 8 need to take place; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Adding farmers to the Public Service Loan
- 10 Forgiveness Program will create a pathway for young people
- 11 with student debt to succeed in agriculture; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Farmers are critical to our nation's well-being
- 13 as they produce the food we eat, steward nearly half the
- 14 country's land, and support rural economies; therefore, be it
- 15 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- 16 HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- 17 we believe farming is an integral public service and that
- 18 farmers constitute public service professionals; and be it
- 19 further
- 20 RESOLVED, That we urge the U.S. Congress to expand the
- 21 Public Service Loan Forgiveness Program so that it includes

- 1 farming as an applicable career for loan forgiveness; and be
- 2 it further
- 3 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
- 4 delivered to the President of the United States, the U.S.
- 5 Senate Majority Leader, the U.S. Senate Minority Leader, the
- 6 U.S. Speaker of the House, the U.S. House of Representatives
- 7 Minority Leader, and all members of the Illinois Congressional
- 8 Delegation.
