WHEREAS, The state and local tax (SALT) deduction allows 2 3 families that pay local property taxes, state and local sales 4 taxes, and state income taxes to deduct those taxes from their 5 federal income tax; and 6 WHEREAS, This deduction prevents families from being 7 double taxed, once by the federal government and again by the 8 state; and 9 WHEREAS, The state and local tax deduction has broad 10 bipartisan support and has been helping Illinoisans since 1913; and 11 12 WHEREAS, The 2017 Tax Cuts and Jobs Act capped the SALT 13 deduction at \$10,000; and 14 WHEREAS, The U.S. Treasury Department estimated that 15 almost 11 million Americans would no longer be able to deduct over \$300 billion in state and local taxes as a result of the 16 17 SALT deduction cap; and WHEREAS, Under current SALT rules, married couples have 18 their SALT deduction cut in half relative to two individual 19
