2 WHEREAS, Bronzeville is a center of African-American life 3 and culture in Chicago and is historically known as the city's 4 "Black Metropolis"; and

5 WHEREAS, Bronzeville is home to a diverse business 6 community, historic landmarks, and lively events, including 7 the annual Bud Billiken Parade that draws more than one 8 million spectators each August; and

9 WHEREAS, Bronzeville is known for its rich history and 10 flourishing modern-day renaissance; its cultural contributions are vast, and it brought the world Pulitzer Prize-winner 11 12 Gwendolvn Brooks, civil rights activist Ida B. Wells, legendary musician Louis Armstrong, founder and publisher of 13 14 the country's most prominent African-American what was newspaper, the Chicago Defender, and the creator of the Bud 15 16 Billiken Parade Robert Abbott, and more; and

17 WHEREAS, Bronzeville's remaining historic remnants attract 18 many to the area; notable surviving structures are the old 19 Chicago Defender Building, the Overton Hygienic Building, the 20 Supreme Life Building, and the Eighth Regiment Armory; and
