23 Section 15. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 24 as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of

18 Section 20. The amounts appropriated for repairs and 19 maintenance, and other capital improvements in Section 10 for 20 repairs and maintenance, roof repairs and/or replacements and 21 miscellaneous capital improvements at the Department's various 22 institutions are to include construction, reconstruction, 23 improvements, repairs and installation of capital facilities, 24 costs of planning, supplies, materials and all other expenses SB0387 -8- OMB102 00018 FJS 10018 b required for roof and other types of repairs and maintenance, capital improvements, and purchase of land.

No contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for repairs and maintenance and other capital improvements from appropriations made in Section 10 of this Article until after the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by the Governor.

8 Section 25. The sum of \$6,400, or so much thereof as may 9 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Juvenile 10 Justice from the General Revenue Fund for costs and expenses 11 associated with payment of statewide hospitalization.

Section 30. The amount of \$363,400, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Juvenile Justice for the purposes of investigating complaints, evaluating policies and procedures, and securing the rights of the youth committed to the Department of Juvenile Justice, including youth released on Aftercare before final discharge.

Section 35. The amount of \$58,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Juvenile Justice for costs associated with SB0387 -9- OMB102 00018 FJS 10018 b
