Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
21B-30 as follows:

(b) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the 9 State Educator Preparation and Licensure Board, shall design 10 and implement a system of examinations, which shall be 11 required prior to the issuance of educator licenses. These 12 examinations and indicators must be based on national and 13 14 State professional teaching standards, as determined by the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State 15 16 Educator Preparation and Licensure Board. The State Board of 17 Education may adopt such rules as may be necessary to implement and administer this Section. 18

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(c) (Blank).

20 (c-5) The State Board must adopt rules to implement a 21 paraprofessional competency test. This test would allow an 22 applicant seeking an Educator License with Stipulations with a 23 paraprofessional educator endorsement to obtain the SB0808 Engrossed - 2 - LRB102 04616 CMG 14635 b

endorsement if he or she passes the test and meets the other requirements of subparagraph (J) of paragraph (2) of Section 21B-20 other than the higher education requirements.

(d) All applicants seeking a State license shall be
required to pass a test of content area knowledge for each area
of endorsement for which there is an applicable test. There
shall be no exception to this requirement. No candidate shall
be allowed to student teach or serve as the teacher of record
until he or she has passed the applicable content area test.

11 (f) Except as otherwise provided in this Article, 12 beginning on September 1, 2015, all candidates completing teacher preparation programs in this State and all candidates 13 subject to Section 21B-35 of this Code are required to pass a 14 15 teacher performance assessment approved by the State Board of 16 Education, in consultation with the State Educator Preparation 17 and Licensure Board. Subject to appropriation, an individual who holds a Professional Educator License and is employed for 18 19 a minimum of one school year by a school district designated as 20 Tier 1 under Section 18-8.15 may, after application to the State Board, receive from the State Board a refund for any 21 22 costs associated with completing the teacher performance 23 assessment under this subsection.

(g) The content area knowledge test and the teacher performance assessment shall be the tests that from time to time are designated by the State Board of Education, in SB0808 Engrossed - 3 - LRB102 04616 CMG 14635 b

consultation with the State Educator Preparation and Licensure 1 2 Board, and may be tests prepared by an educational testing 3 organization or tests designed by the State Board of Education, in consultation with the State Educator Preparation 4 5 and Licensure Board. The test of content area knowledge shall assess content knowledge in a specific subject field. The 6 7 tests must be designed to be racially neutral to ensure that no 8 person taking the tests is discriminated against on the basis 9 of race, color, national origin, or other factors unrelated to 10 the person's ability to perform as a licensed employee. The 11 score required to pass the tests shall be fixed by the State 12 Board of Education, in consultation with the State Educator 13 and Licensure Board. The Preparation tests shall be 14 administered not fewer than 3 times a year at such time and 15 place as may be designated by the State Board of Education, in 16 consultation with the State Educator Preparation and Licensure 17 Board.

The State Board shall implement a test or tests to assess 18 19 the speaking, reading, writing, and grammar skills of 20 applicants for an endorsement or a license issued under subdivision (G) of paragraph (2) of Section 21B-20 of this 21 22 Code in the English language and in the language of the 23 transitional bilingual education program requested by the 24 applicant.

(h) Except as provided in Section 34-6 of this Code, the
 provisions of this Section shall apply equally in any school

1 district subject to Article 34 of this Code.

2 (i) The rules developed to implement and enforce the testing requirements under this Section shall include without 3 limitation provisions governing test selection, 4 test 5 validation and determination of а passing score, administration of the tests, frequency of administration, 6 7 applicant fees, frequency of applicants taking the tests, the years for which a score is valid, and appropriate special 8 9 accommodations. The State Board of Education shall develop 10 such rules as may be needed to ensure uniformity from year to 11 year in the level of difficulty for each form of an assessment.

12 (j) Beginning with the 2021-2022 school year, in order to 13 obtain a license under this Article, a student teacher 14 candidate may not be required to videotape himself or herself 15 or his or her students in a classroom setting.
