1 AN ACT concerning government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 220/2) (from Ch. 127, par. 742)
- 7 Sec. 2. Definitions. For <u>the</u> purpose of this Act:
- 9 government as defined in the Illinois Constitution of 1970,
 10 any school district, any public community college district,
 11 any public building commission, the State of Illinois, any
 12 agency of the State government or of the United States, or of
 13 any other State, any political subdivision of another State,
- 14 and any combination of the above pursuant to an
- 15 intergovernmental agreement which includes provisions for a
- 16 governing body of the agency created by the agreement.
- 17 For the purposes of this Act, "public agency" includes the
- 18 Mid-America Intermodal Authority Port District created under
- 19 the Mid-America Intermodal Authority Port District Act.
- 20 (2) The term "state" shall mean a state of the United
- 21 States.
