SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/356z.33

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Removes the age limitation for coverage in provisions concerning coverage for epinephrine injectors. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by changing Section 356z.33 as follows:
- 6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.33)
- 7 Sec. 356z.33. Coverage for epinephrine injectors. A group or individual policy of accident and health insurance or a 8 9 managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after the effective date of this amendatory Act 10 of the 102nd General Assembly the effective date of this 11 amendatory Act of the 101st General Assembly shall provide 12 coverage for medically necessary epinephrine injectors for 13 14 persons 18 years of age or under. As used in this Section, "epinephrine injector" has the meaning given to that term in 15 16 Section 5 of the Epinephrine Injector Act.

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
