1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Unemployment Insurance Act is amended by adding Section 1502.5 as follows:
- 6 (820 ILCS 405/1502.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 1502.5. Benefit charges.</u>
- A. With respect to any benefits that are paid for a week of
 unemployment that begins on or after January 3, 2021, and
 before September 4, 2021, and would not have been paid but for
 subsection D of Section 612, notwithstanding any other
 provisions to the contrary, an employer that is subject to the
 payment of contributions shall not be chargeable for any
 benefit charges.
- B. With respect to any regular benefits paid for a week of 15 unemployment that begins on or after January 3, 2021, and 16 before September 4, 2021, and would not have been paid but for 17 subsection D of Section 612, notwithstanding any other 18 19 provisions to the contrary except subsection E of Section 20 1502.4, a nonprofit organization that is subject to making 21 payments in lieu of contributions shall be chargeable for 50% 22 of the benefits paid if the week begins before April 4, 2021,
- 23 and 75% if the week begins on or after April 4, 2021.

- 1 C. With respect to any benefits paid for a week of unemployment that begins on or after January 3, 2021, and 2 3 before September 4, 202<u>1, and would not have been paid but for</u> subsection D of Section 612, notwithstanding any other 4 provisions to the contrary except subsection E of Section 5 6 1502.4 and irrespective of whether the State or local government paid the individual who received the benefits wages 7 for insured work during the individual's base period, the 8 9 State and any local government that is subject to making 10 payments in lieu of contributions shall be chargeable for 50% 11 of the benefits paid if the week begins before April 4, 2021, 12 and 75% if the week begins on or after April 4, 2021.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
