SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

770 ILCS 60/6

from Ch. 82, par. 6

Amends the Mechanics Lien Act. Provides that the changes made by Public Act 97-966, to provisions governing the circumstances in which it is not necessary to fix by contract a time for the completion or a time for payment in order to obtain a lien under the Act, are operative from January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2026 (rather than December 31, 2021). Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Mechanics Lien Act is amended by changing

 Section 6 as follows:
- 6 (770 ILCS 60/6) (from Ch. 82, par. 6)
- Sec. 6. In no event shall it be necessary to fix or 8 stipulate in any contract a time for the completion or a time 9 for payment in order to obtain a lien under this Act, provided, that the work is done or material furnished within three years 10 from the commencement of said work or the commencement of 11 furnishing said material in the case of work done or material 12 furnished as to residential property; and within 5 years from 13 14 the commencement of said work or the commencement of furnishing said material in the case of work done or material 15 16 furnished as to any other type of property. The changes made by Public Act 97-966 are operative from January 1, 2013 through 17 December 31, 2026 2021. 18
