2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 2663 by replacing
3	everything after the enacting clause with the following:
4	"Section 5. The Public Water District Act is amended by
5	adding Section 28.2 as follows:
6	(70 ILCS 3705/28.2 new)
7	Sec. 28.2. Alternate method of annexation. The board o
8	trustees of any water district may annex territory which is
9	not within the corporate limits of the water district if:
10	(1) the new territory is contiguous to the annexing
11	water district and not currently served by another water
12	district; and
13	(2) the new territory is without a source of quality
14	water not contaminated by methane and is within 3 miles o
15	a source of a methane contamination.
16	The annexation shall be accomplished only by ordinance and

1 the ordinance shall include a description of the annexed 2 territory and a map of the annexed territory certified as true 3 and accurate by the clerk of the water district shall be filed 4 with the county clerk of the county in which the annexed 5 territory is located. The territory to be annexed shall be 6 considered to be contiquous to the water district notwithstanding that the territory to be annexed is divided 7 by, or that the territory to be annexed is separated from the 8 9 water district by, one or more railroad right of waters, 10 public easements, or properties owned by a public utility, a forest preserve district, a public agency, or a not-for-profit 11 corporation. A two-thirds vote of the board is required to 12 13 annex such territory to the district and action of the board shall be by ordinance of annexation and the vote on such 14 15 ordinance shall be entered upon the records of the district.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
