AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

7 Section 10. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller from 8 9 the Comptroller's Administrative Fund for the discharge of duties of the office. 10

11 Section 15. The sum of \$50,300, or so much thereof as may 12 be necessary, is appropriated to the State Comptroller from the 13 State Lottery Fund for expenses in connection with the State 14 Lottery.
