SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$42,321,300 from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Elections for operational expenses, grants, reimbursements for its ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2021.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. In addition to other sums appropriated, the sum of \$19,068,600, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the State Board of Elections for operational expenses, grants, reimbursements, and the Census 2020 Redistricting Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021.

10 Section 10.
