## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5F-35

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that the Department of Healthcare and Family Services shall provide each managed care organization with the quarterly fee-for-service facility-specific nursing component (rather than facility-specific RUG-IV nursing component) per diem along with any add-ons for enhanced care services, support component per diem, and capital component per diem effective for each nursing home under contract with the managed care organization. Provides that no managed care contract shall provide for a level of reimbursement lower than the fee-for-service rate in effect for the facility at the time service is rendered. Provides that managed care organizations are expressly prohibited, at any time and for any reason, from offering, negotiating, or entering into contracts with a nursing facility for a level of compensation less than the fee-for-service rate in effect at the time the service is rendered. Effective immediately.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by 5 changing Section 5F-35 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5F-35)

7 Sec. 5F-35. Reimbursement. The Department shall provide 8 each managed care organization with the quarterly 9 fee-for-service facility-specific RUG-IV nursing component per diem along with any add-ons for enhanced care services, 10 support component per diem, and capital component per diem 11 effective for each nursing home under contract with the 12 managed care organization. No managed care contract shall 13 14 provide for a level of reimbursement lower than the fee-for-service rate in effect for the facility at the time 15 16 service is rendered. Managed care organizations are expressly 17 prohibited, at any time and for any reason, from offering, negotiating, or entering into contracts with a nursing 18 19 facility for a level of compensation less than the fee-for-service rate in effect at the time the service is 20 21 rendered.
