1 Section 50. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Parity Advancement 3 Fund to the Illinois Department of Insurance for costs and 4 expenses related to or in support of parity compliance 5 advocacy, consumer education, and any other initiatives that 6 support parity implementation and enforcement on behalf of 7 consumers.
