SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates specified amounts from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for specified purposes. Effective July 1, 2022.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Article 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much of those
6 amounts as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
7 purposes named, are appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
8 to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of
9 the State Appellate Defender:

10	For Personal Services	\$19,615,200
11	For State Contributions to Social Security	1,500,000
12	For Contractual Services	2,680,100
13	For Travel	47,000
14	For Commodities	33,000
15	For Printing	25,000
16	For Equipment	128,700
17	For EDP	1,104,100
18	For Telecommunications	38,000
19	Total	\$25,171,700

20 Section 10. The amount of \$195,000, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund

1 to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for the ordinary
2 and contingent expenses of the Expungement Program.

3 Section 15. The amount \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
5 the Office of the State Appellate Defender to provide statewide
6 training to Public Defenders under the Public Defender Training
7 Program.

8 Section 20. The amount of \$591,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from General Revenue Fund to
10 the Office of the State Appellate Defender to develop a Juvenile
11 Defender Resource Center.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
13 2022.
