A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Article 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$598,138,100, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Illinois State Board of Education for Early Childhood
8 Education.

9 Article 2

10 Section 5. The sum of \$7,720,300, or so much thereof as may
11 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
12 the Department of Human Services for grants and administrative
13 costs associated with the Parents Too Soon program.

14 Section 10. The sum of \$10,890,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
16 to the Department of Human Services for grants and
17 administrative costs associated with the Healthy Families
18 Illinois program.

2 costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in
3 this Section.

4 Article 4

5 Section 5. The sum of \$45,000,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Illinois State Board of Education for grants and
8 administrative costs associated with after-school programming.

9 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
10 2022.
