AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Article 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$598,138,100, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 7 to the Illinois State Board of Education for Early Childhood 8 Education.

Article 2

Section 5. The sum of \$7,720,300, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for grants and administrative costs associated with the Parents Too Soon program.

Section 10. The sum of \$10,890,000, or so much thereof as 14 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 16 the Department Human Services for to of grants and 17 administrative costs associated with the Healthy Families 18 Illinois program.

1 Section 15. The sum of \$19,622,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund for grants 3 to the Department of Human Services and administrative costs associated with Teen Responsibility, 4 Education, Achievement, Caring, and Hope (Teen REACH) after-5 6 school programs.

Section 20. The sum of \$3,030,499,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for grants and administrative costs associated with the Child Care Assistance Program.

12 Section 25. The amount of \$14,373,600, or so much thereof 13 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Human 14 Services from the General Revenue Fund for grants and 15 administrative expenses associated with the Redeploy Illinois 16 program.

Article 3

18 Section 5. The sum of \$529,566,200, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Student 20 Assistance Commission from the General Revenue Fund for grant 21 awards to students eligible for the Monetary Award Program, as SB4202 -3- LRB102 26637 RJF 37406 b provided by law, and for agency administrative and operational costs not to exceed 2 percent of the total appropriation in this Section.

5 Section 5. The sum of \$45,000,000, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 7 to the Illinois State Board of Education for grants and 8 administrative costs associated with after-school programming.
