SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender \$26,750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for implementation of Public Act 102-1104. Appropriates from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor \$26,750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for implementation of Public Act 102-1104. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$26,750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Office of the State Appellate Defender for implementation of Public Act 102-1104.
- 8 Section 10. The sum of \$26,750,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund 10 to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor for 11 implementation of Public Act 102-1104.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
