1 SENATE RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, According to information compiled by the 3 Governor's Office of Executive Appointments, the State of 4 Illinois has over 300 boards, commissions, task forces, 5 councils, and authorities (referred to as "boards commissions"); and 6 7 WHEREAS, These boards and commissions are created by 8 statutes, resolutions, and Executive Orders to serve a variety 9 of advisory and substantive functions; and 10 WHEREAS, There are cumulatively hundreds of members on these boards and commissions; and 11 12 WHEREAS, Compensation to members of boards and commissions 13 ranges from set salaries, stipends, or per diems to reimbursement of expenses only; and 14 15 WHEREAS, State agency directors and employees often serve as members of boards and commissions or provide administrative 16 17 support to boards and commissions, or both, in addition to performing their regular duties; and 18 19 WHEREAS, According to findings of the Auditor General, 20 some boards and commissions are not fulfilling their mission,

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1	including	boards	and	commissions	that	were	never	established,
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- 2 were established at one time but are now inactive, have
- 3 long-term vacancies, have members serving expired terms, or
- 4 have failed to meet periodically as required; therefore, be it
- 5 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SECOND GENERAL
- 6 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that the Auditor General is
- 7 directed to conduct a management audit of the State's boards
- 8 and commissions; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That the audit include, but not be limited to, 10 the following for every known State board and commission:
- 11 (1) its name and purpose;
 - (2) the number of appointed members and the number of vacancies and the length of the vacancies;
 - (3) costs of member stipends, salaries, and per diems and expense reimbursements to members and State officials and employees for attending board and commission meetings during Fiscal Years 2021 and 2022;
 - (4) the date of each of the board's or commission's meetings during Fiscal Years 2021 and 2022 and the number of members in attendance and the number of members absent; and
 - (5) identification of any report or work product prepared and made available by the board or commission during Fiscal Years 2021 and 2022; and be it further

- 1 RESOLVED, That all State agencies and boards and 2 commissions and any other entity having information relevant 3 to this audit cooperate fully and promptly with the Auditor 4 General's Office in the conduct of this audit; and be it 5 further
- RESOLVED, That the Auditor General commence this audit as
 soon as possible and report his or her findings and
 recommendations upon completion in accordance with the
 provisions of Section 3-14 of the Illinois State Auditing Act;
 and be it further
- 11 RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be delivered to 12 the Auditor General.
