8 Moline Community College; he served as a communication chief
9 in the U.S. Army from 1953 to 1955; he married Dolores Ann

12 WHEREAS, Joseph Di Iulio worked as an electronic
13 technician with Bendix Aviation, Davenport from 1956 to 1970;
14 he was one of the founders of Agricultural Electronics,
15 Bettendorf and was with the company from 1970 until 1977; he
16 worked as a stock broker with Stifel Nicolaus, Moline from
17 1977 to 1990 and then with Robert B. Ausdal, Davenport from
18 1990 until his retirement in April of 2004; and

20 parents and his siblings, Della (Albert) Dumolien, Edith
21 Senatra, Louis Di Iulio, and Anne (Bob) Steele; and
