- WHEREAS, CTE in Illinois places equity at the forefront of decision-making, instructional programming, and student support services; and

- WHEREAS, February 23, 2022 marks the 105th anniversary of
- 16 the signing of the Smith-Hughes Vocational Education Act of

- 20 Education that continues today with the Strengthening Career
