SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

60 ILCS 1/207-5

Amends the Township Special Service Areas Article of the Township Code. Removes a provision in the definition of "township special service area" limiting special service areas to a township in a county with a population of more than 3,000,000. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 207-5 as follows:
- 6 (60 ILCS 1/207-5)
- 7 Sec. 207-5. Definitions. In this Article:
- 8 "Township special service area" means a contiguous area
- 9 within a township in a county with a population of more than
- 3,000,000 in which special services are provided in addition
- 11 to those services provided generally throughout the township.
- 12 Territory is considered contiguous even though one or more
- 13 completely surrounded portions of the territory are excluded
- from the township special service area.
- 15 "Special services" means the land acquisition,
- development, construction, and maintenance of streets, street
- 17 lighting, sidewalks, sanitary sewer systems, storm sewer
- 18 systems, water systems, alleys, and other necessary adjuncts
- 19 within the township special service area.

- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 22 becoming law.
