SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

60 ILCS 1/207-5

Amends the Township Special Service Areas Article of the Township Code. Removes a provision in the definition of "township special service area" limiting special service areas to a township in a county with a population of more than 3,000,000. Effective immediately.

A BILL FOR

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing
5 Section 207-5 as follows:

6 (60 ILCS 1/207-5)

7 Sec. 207-5. Definitions. In this Article:

8 "Township special service area" means a contiguous area
9 within a township ~~in a county with a population of more than~~
10 ~~3,000,000~~ in which special services are provided in addition
11 to those services provided generally throughout the township.
12 Territory is considered contiguous even though one or more
13 completely surrounded portions of the territory are excluded
14 from the township special service area.

15 "Special services" means the land acquisition,
16 development, construction, and maintenance of streets, street
17 lighting, sidewalks, sanitary sewer systems, storm sewer
18 systems, water systems, alleys, and other necessary adjuncts
19 within the township special service area.
