- 18 Section 10. The Landscape Architecture Registration Act is
- 19 amended by changing Section 10 and by adding Section 53 as

- Sec. 10. Definitions. As used in this Act:

- 1 "Address of record" means the designated address recorded
- 2 by the Department in the applicant's application file or
- 3 registrant's registration file as maintained by the
- 4 Department.
- 5 "Board" means the Registered Landscape Architecture
- 6 Registration Board.
- 7 "Department" means the Department of Financial and
- 8 Professional Regulation.
- 9 "Email address of record" means the designated email
- 10 address of record by the Department in the applicant's
- 11 application file or registrant's registration file as
- maintained by the Department.
- "Landscape architecture" means the art and science of
- 14 arranging land, together with the spaces and objects upon it,
- for the purpose of creating a safe, efficient, healthful, and
- 16 aesthetically pleasing physical environment for human use and
- enjoyment, as performed by landscape architects.
- "Landscape architectural practice" means the offering or
- 19 furnishing of professional services in connection with a
- 20 landscape architecture project that do not require the seal of
- 21 an architect, land surveyor, professional engineer, or
- 22 structural engineer. These services may include, but are not
- 23 limited to, providing preliminary studies; developing design
- 24 concepts; planning for the relationships of physical
- 25 improvements and intended uses of the site; establishing form
- and aesthetic elements; developing those technical details on

- the site that are exclusive of any building or structure; 1
- preparing and coordinating technical submissions; 2 and
- 3 conducting site observation of a landscape architecture
- 4 project.
- 5 "Registered landscape architect" means a person who, based
- 6 on education, experience, and examination in the field of
- landscape architecture, is registered under this Act. 7
- 8 "Secretary" means the Secretary of Financial
- 9 Professional Regulation. The Secretary may designate his or
- 10 her duties under this Act to a designee of his or her choice,
- 11 including, but not limited to, the Director of Professional
- Regulation. 12
