Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

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ARTICLE 1

5	Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6	as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated for the
7	objects and purposes hereinafter named, to meet the ordinary
8	and contingent expenses of the Illinois Council on
9	Developmental Disabilities:

4 Section 5. The amount of \$2,500,000, or so much thereof 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Council on 6 Developmental Disabilities Fund to the Illinois Council on 7 Developmental Disabilities for awards and grants to community 8 agencies and other State agencies.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Council on Developmental 11 Disabilities Fund to the Illinois Council on Developmental 12 Disabilities for awards and grants pursuant to Public Law 116-13 260, Section 301 of the Public Health Service Act and Division 14 M, Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,16 2023.
